

Information clause for the user of the integrated library system

Pursuant to Art. 13 of the Regulation 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data – general data protection regulation (Journal of Laws EU L 119/1 of 4 May 2016 – GDPR), the Warsaw University of Technology hereby informs that:

1. The administrator of your personal data is the Warsaw University of Technology, represented by the Rector, with the official seat at pl. Politechniki 1, 00-661 Warsaw.
2. The administrator has appointed the Data Protection Inspector (DPI) to supervise the processing of personal data. The Inspector can be contacted at the email address: iod@pw.edu.pl
3. The administrator shall process the personal data: name and surname, address, PESEL number/number of the ID document, date of birth, student record book number, library card no. The scope of the personal data processed is laid down in the Statute of the Warsaw University of Technology §147 of 26 June 2019.
4. Your personal data shall be processed by the Administrator in order to complete the tasks of the Warsaw University of Technology Main Library related to user administration and protection of library resources - the legal basis of the processing of your personal data is Art. 6 section 1 letter c of GDPR; Art. 49, section 2 of the Law on Higher Education and Science, Act of 20 July 2018, Dz.U.2021.0.478; Art. 21 of the Act of 27 June 1997 on libraries, Dz.U.2019.0.1479.
5. You are entitled to access your personal data and you have the right to correct the data, the right to demand to delete them, limit the processing of the data, the right to object to the processing of the data. Since the processing of your data is not based on your consent, you are not entitled to transfer the data.
6. Access to your personal data may be granted to the producer of the library software, with its seat in Israel (as a processing entity) – a country which ensures a relevant level of protection pursuant to decision of the Commission of 31 January 2011 on the basis of the Directive 95/46/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council on protection of personal data in the state of Israel with regard to automated processing of personal data; as well as other entities legally authorized which may be given tasks related to the processing of personal data by the Warsaw University of Technology.
7. The Warsaw University of Technology does not use towards you automated decision making tools, including profiling you.
8. Providing your personal data is not obligatory but it is necessary for the purposes they were collected for.
9. Your personal data will be processed for the period of achievement of the purpose of the processing, and then for the period necessary to secure possible claims or to complete any other tasks arising from legal regulations. Closure of library accounts or documentation related to them is done once a year on a regular basis.
10. You are entitled to make a complaint to the supervisory authority - President of the Office for Personal Data Protection if you find that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR Regulation.
